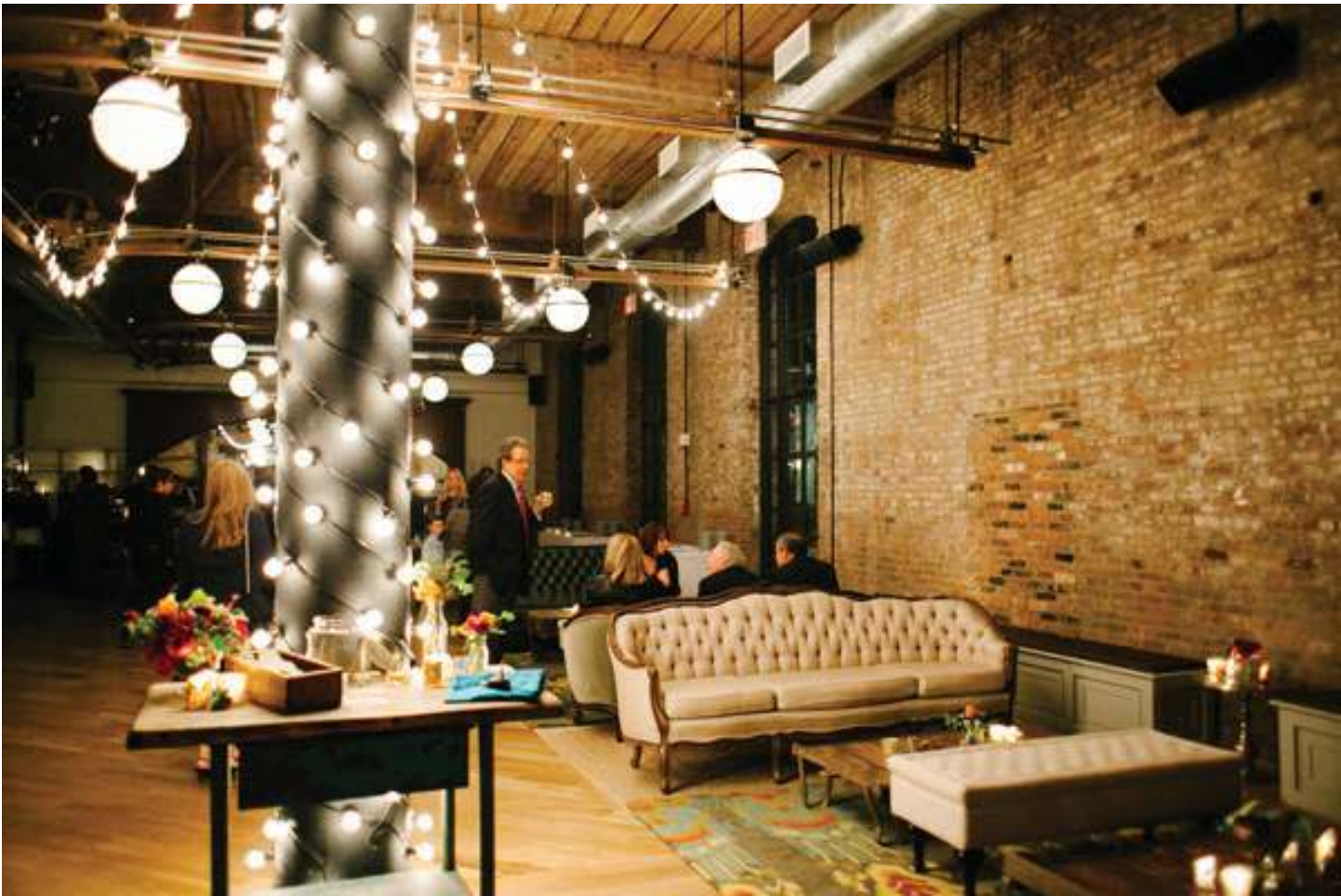
REAL WYTHE HOTEL WEDDING: ALEXIS + CHRIS
