Wythe Hotel

The Nuptials: The developers of this 72-room hotel, a former barrel-making factory, must have had weddings in mind when renovating. The Main Event Hall boasts historic (albeit hipster-ish) charm with its original 16-foot pine ceiling and masonry walls—there’s also a dance floor and built-in sound system. The in-house restaurant Reynard (the latest from Andrew Tarlow of Williamsburg’s Diner and Marlow & Sons) showcases menus abundant with seasonal fare.

After-Party: Hop in the elevator to the sprawling sixth-floor bar The Ides and sip dark and stormies, while taking in majestic Manhattan across the river.

Hangover Cure: Nosh on sticky buns or bialys and whitefish with your guests before they hit the road.
